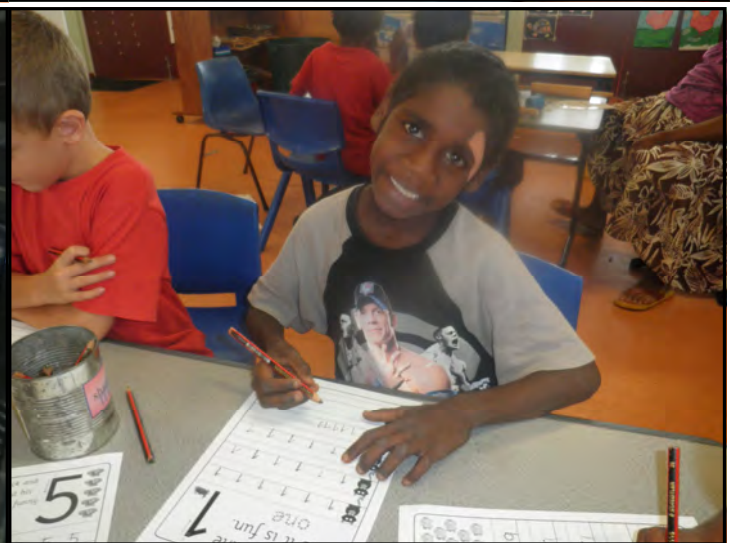
NEWSLETTER Term 4, Week 6, 2012
