-RESULTS FROM 2012 NAPLAN TESTING⁶ National Literacy & Numeracy Testing conducted in May this year. Results available on ACARA myschools website.

SP Excursion to HALLS CREEK HOSPITAL

Our final excursion for 2012 was a visit to the Halls Creek Hospital. Miss Peggy, Miss Katherine and Mr Martin were the teaching staff that accompanied us.

We were met by Miss Angela who told us she was the D.O.N. This meant she was the Director of Nursing, or the boss of all the nurses.

Miss Angela is only here for a short time because she normally lives and works in Broome.

Miss Angela gave us a tour of the hospital which lasted for about 45 minutes. During that time we saw lots of different things that were very, very interesting. In the next few sentences I will describe some of the things we saw.

Our tour followed the procedure of a patient visiting the hospital. We started by the Reporting Desk, where our details were taken so that our files could be retrieved from the Records Department. Everybody who has been to the hospital has a recovered file. This allows the hospital to build up a medical history of a person.
